



## DOCUMENTS TO BRING TO WORKSHOP

### GENERAL DOCUMENTS

- Your Permanent Resident Card (Green Card)
- Your most recent tax return and W-2 forms
- Your current and all expired passports
- All documents you have about your immigration record
- Filing fee – varies by income level
  - If you plan to pay for the application yourself you will need a check, cashier's check, or money order made out to "U.S. Department of Homeland Security" in the amount of \$725.
  - You may qualify for a fee waiver. In order to check your eligibility for a fee waiver, you must bring the following:
    - Proof of DSHS public benefits such as your award letter, or
    - Proof of your income: 2017 Tax Returns and recent paystubs

### ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS TO BRING (IF APPLICABLE)

- Marriage certificate
- Proof of your spouse's U.S. citizenship or permanent resident status
- Divorce decree(s)
- Legal name change document
- Proof of having supported your dependents
- If you have ever been arrested or detained by any law enforcement officer for any reason (except parking tickets), bring a Court Docket from the Criminal Court
